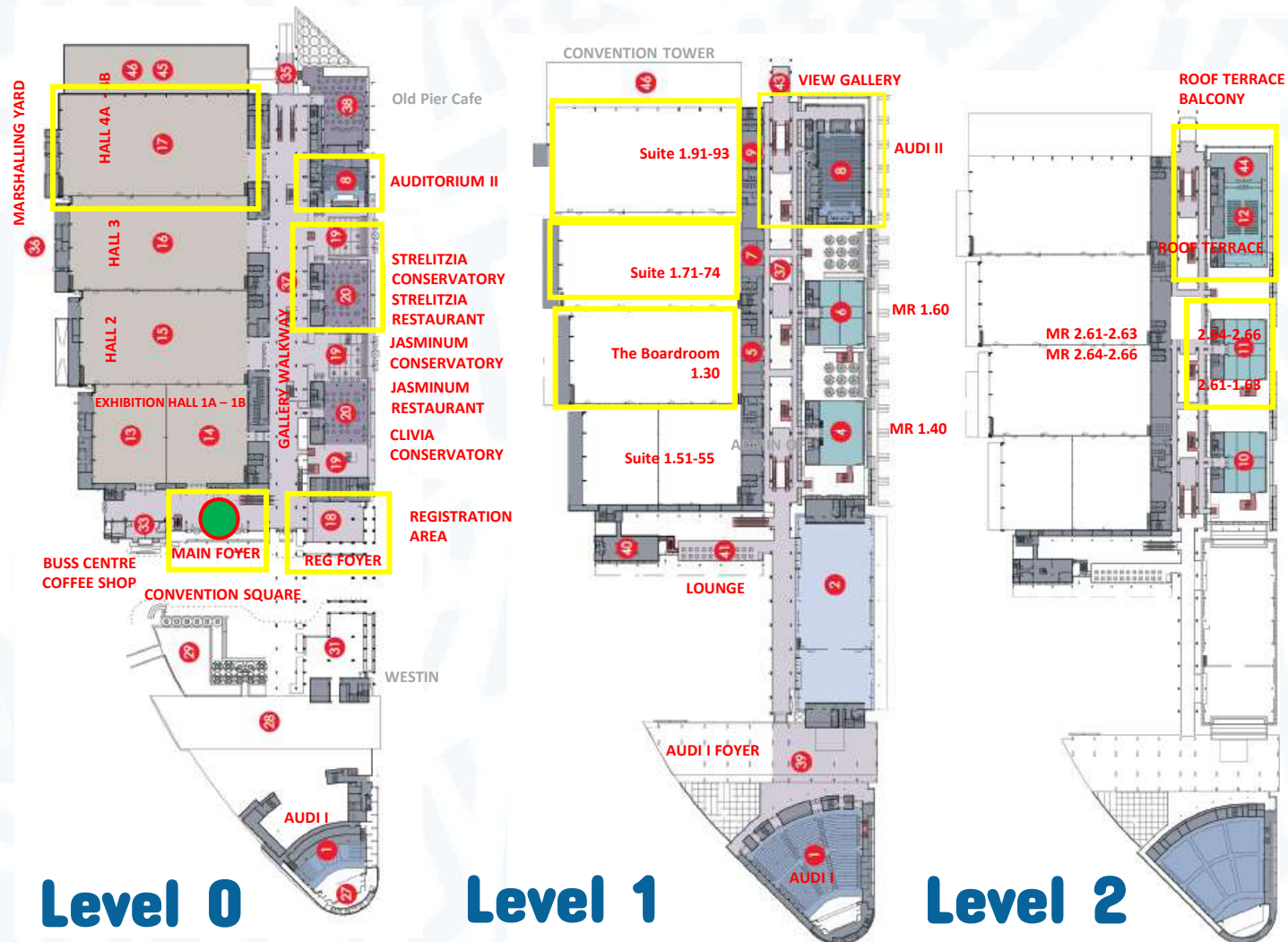

Exhibition

We will be offering Tension Fabric System (TFS) exhibition booths, which allows fabric to be easily fitted and removed. The fabric is stretched over the length of the exhibition stand.

The stand consists of black anodized poles, and the stretch fabric that spans across these can either be plain (we supply white) or branded with your artwork. Here's the sweetener - you get to take your branded prints with you at the end of the symposium, to re-use at future events.

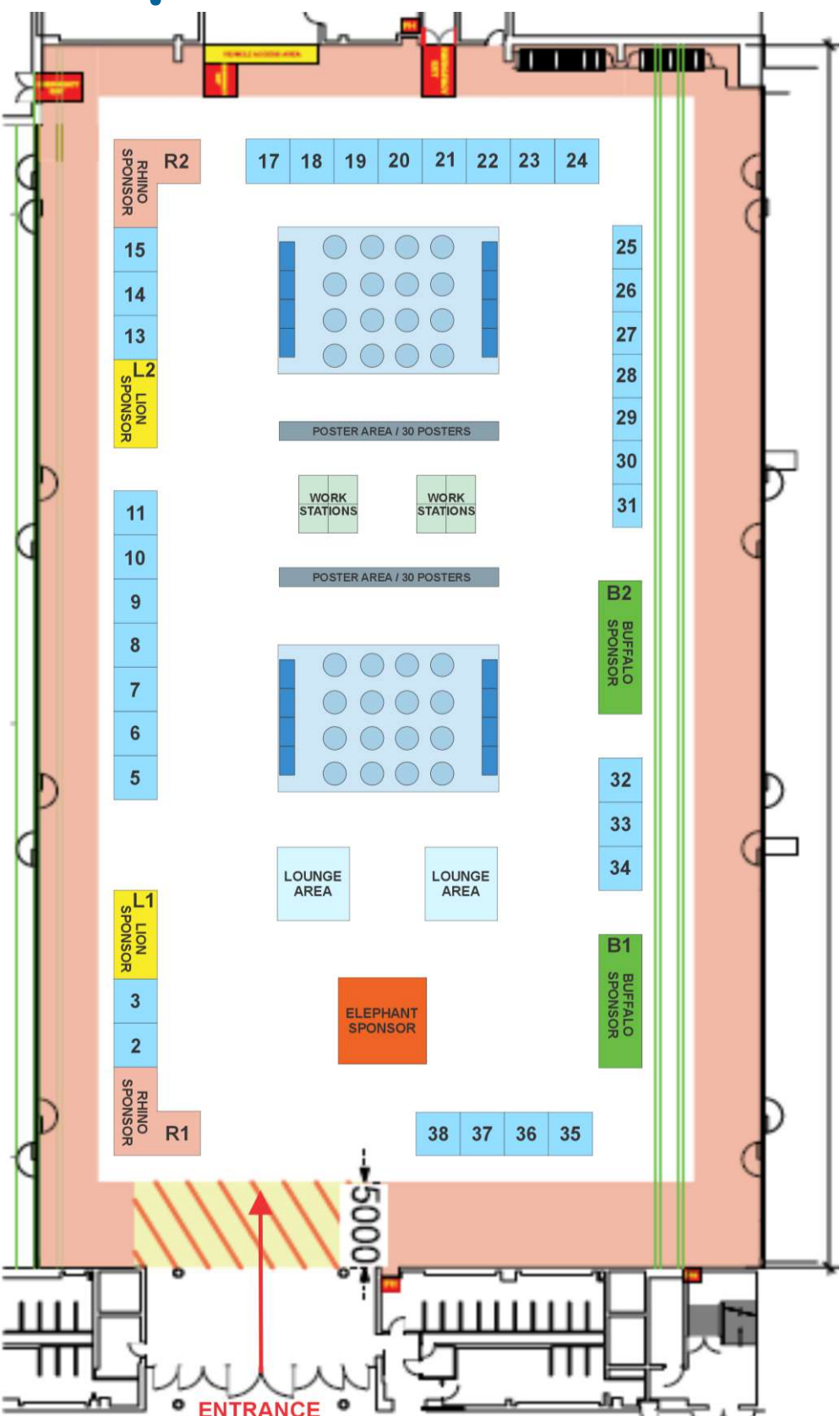

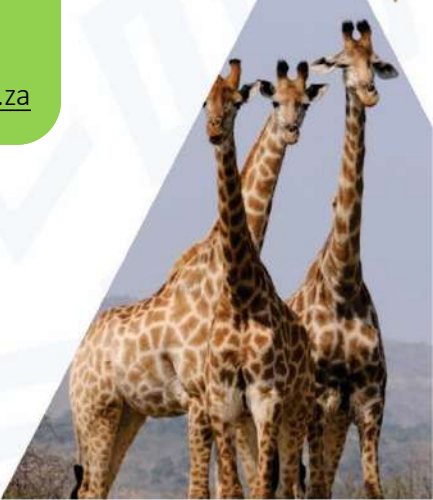
